All students **must** pay 50% or more of the tuition fees for the Semester and register for courses before the Residential School begins. The full fees for the semester are **ZMW8**, **000.00**. This

means that students must pay not less than **ZMW4000.00** (as 50%) before registration. Students who pay full fees (100%) for the semester will receive **5% discount**.

Tuition fees should be deposited into any of the following Bank Accounts of the Zambian Open University:

Students should indicate their full-names and National Registration Card (NRC) number when depositing the fees.
